

Workshop registration

Travel

Visa

Although it is possible to obtain a visa at the port of entry at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, it is advisable to get a visa before travelling as there can be very long queues at the airport. The fee for obtaining a visa at the point of entry is USD 50 for an Ordinary Visa.

Nationals of most countries who require a visa to enter Kenya can apply for an eVisa via www.ecitizen.go.ke. Nationals of the following countries require a referred visa: Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Cameroon, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Formerly North Korea), Eritrea, Iraq, Kosovo, Lebanon, Libya, Mali, Palestine, Senegal, Somalia, Syria, Tajikistan and, Yemen.

Airport transfers



Upon arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), you will be received by ICRAF's accredited taxi drivers or bus drivers (for bigger groups) who will drive you to your hotel. For ease of identification, the driver will be carrying a pager bearing the name SPIA/PIM CONFERENCE and an ICRAF LOGO.

All participants entitled to airport transfer will receive a confirmation of the arrival schedule by email. The departure schedule will be displayed on a pin board outside the Conference Hall.

The weather in Nairobi

Nairobi is situated in Kenya's Central Highlands region and enjoys pleasant weather for most of the year. In winter (June, July) the temperatures are most comfortable and it's very dry.

The average temperature in Nairobi in July is mild at 15.5 °C (60 °F). Afternoons can be fairly warm with average high temperatures reaching 20 °C (68 °F). Overnight temperatures are generally mild with an average low of 10 °C (50 °F).
